Artwork must be prepared for the commercial embroidery machine. Digitizing is the art of programing the stitch pattern to best represent the artwork. There is a one-time digitization fee of \$40.00 for new orders.

Embroidery machines are pre-programmed with a diverse, but limited set of fonts. Other fonts can be digitized as artwork.
