

# HEAT SEALED VINYL

Heat sealed vinyl is a method of cutting vinyl into shapes and applying it to fabric with a heat press. Vinyl can be single-colored, printed or glittered. Typically used in sports to add a name and number to back of a jersey, vinyl can also be used for a wider variety of applications. The vinyl is highly durable.

Heat sealed vinyl is available in a wide range of colors. There is also specialty vinyl, such as colored glittered, that can really make an impression.

Heat sealed vinyl is most commonly used to personalize a sports jersey with a name and number. It is also perfect to personalize gym shirts or organization shirts. Add "Volunteer" quickly and easily to a few event shirts with vinyl.

There are no minimums required for vinyl orders.

Artwork must be vector. Pixel-based artwork would need converted.

Heat Sealed Vinyl does have it's limitations however. Complex designs are difficult to use and thin areas may tear before being applied. Designs are limited to 1-3 colors, with layering of colors being possible. Dye from polyester/moisture-wicking materials may bleed through the vinyl.
